

## Dress Code

Lakewood Ev. Lutheran School requires students to wear a school uniform while in attendance. This includes field trips and off-campus activities, unless otherwise noted by the teacher. All uniform attire must be neat and clean, free of holes or extreme wear. Each piece of clothing must be a solid color (no stripes or patterns or logos on the chest). Shorts, skirts, and jumpers should reach the top of the knee. Belts are suggested if slacks have belt loops. (If it will delay your young child from using the restroom in a timely manner a belt is not required. They must be able to operate the belt independently.) **Most of the shoe should be black, navy, brown, gray, or white and be free of embellishments**, keeping in mind the ability to play and run at recess and PE. Open-toe shoes, sandals, Crocs, or shoes with moving parts (wheels, spinners, etc.) may be worn at home. **The shoelaces should match the main shoe color: black, navy, brown, gray, or white. Socks or tights are required. STUDENTS must be able to put their own shoes on and keep them fastened. Choose Velcro or slip on for children that have not yet learned to tie. Thank you for the support!**

Students will observe modesty, appropriateness, and neatness in their clothing and personal appearance. Clothing should fit correctly, loose but snug. Hats, hoods, or bandanas will not be worn on school grounds unless there is a need due to inclement weather or a special event authorized by the school principal. Hair should be its natural color and haircuts should support learning. At home, makeup may be worn. Temporary tattoos should be hidden. Nail polish may be worn by girls.

**Girls:** Hair should be neat, clean, and trimmed, and should keep vision clear. Hair accessories should be Navy blue, Baby blue, Khaki, Black, Gray, True white, or Land's End Clear Blue Plaid. Girls should have no more than three earrings in each ear, and no other display of body piercing is permitted. The following are the guidelines for the girls' uniform:

Slacks or Shorts	Navy blue, Khaki, Gray, or Black (not jeans)
Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers	Navy blue, Khaki, Gray, Black, or Land's End Clear Blue Plaid
Sweaters, Sweatshirts	Navy blue, Baby blue, Gray, Black, or True white
Shirt	Navy blue, Baby blue, Gray, Black, or True white
Tights, Socks, Leggings	Black, Navy blue, Gray, or True white
Polo Dress *Must have collar	Navy blue, Baby blue, Gray, Black

**Boys:** Hair should be neat, clean, and trimmed, and should keep vision clear. Hair length should not exceed the collar. Body piercing is not permitted. The following are the guidelines for the boys' uniform:

Slacks or Shorts	Navy blue, Khaki, Gray, or Black (not jeans)
Sweaters, Sweatshirts	Navy blue, Baby blue, Gray, Black, or True white
Shirt *Must have collar	Navy blue, Baby blue, Gray, Black, or True white
Socks	Black, Navy blue, Gray, or True white
Bow Tie/Necktie	Black, Navy blue, Baby blue, Gray, or Land's End Clear Blue Plaid

On **Wednesdays**, students can wear jeans and their school leopard sweatshirt or t-shirt as their uniform; otherwise, the school uniform is still required. On this day, hair accessories, socks, and shoes may add to their leopard spirit! See Leopard Checklist for details.

There are occasional Free Dress Days during the school year. On these days, students may choose to not wear their uniform. The clothing they do choose to wear should still reflect the beliefs and values of Lakewood Ev. Lutheran School. In all matters of taste and judgment, the school administrator will have final say, and may choose to have the student change their clothes to meet dress code. Fun/Free Dress Days are a great time to wear fun hair accessories and shoes!

**Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers**

Solid **navy blue, khaki, black, gray, or Land's End Clear Blue Plaid** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos and reach the top of the knee.

**Slacks, Shorts**

Solid **navy blue, khaki, gray, or black** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos. Shorts should reach the top of the knee.

**Sweaters, Sweatshirts (Hoodies are okay. Hood may stay down while inside.)**

Solid **navy blue, baby blue, gray, black, or true white** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos.

**Shirt**

Solid **navy blue, baby blue, gray, black, or true white** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos.

**Polo Dresses \*must have collar**

Solid **navy blue, baby blue, gray, black** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos.

**Tights, Leggings, Socks**

Solid **black, navy blue, gray, or true white** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos. **Socks or tights are required.** Leggings are treated as tights and bottoms may be covered unless there are distinct square pockets on the bottom area of the leggings.

**Shoes (Choose Velcro or slip on for children that have not yet learned to tie.)**

Most of the shoes should be **black, navy, brown, gray, or true white** and free of embellishments.

**Shoe Laces**

Should match the main shoe color: **black, navy, brown, gray, or true white.**

**Head Accessories**

**Hair accessories** should be **navy blue, baby blue, khaki, black, gray, true white, or Land's End Clear Blue Plaid.** **Hats, hoods, or bandanas** will not be worn on school grounds unless there is a need due to inclement weather or a special event authorized by the school principal.

**Shorts**

**Socks**

Solid **black, navy blue, gray, or true white** in color, free of patterns, stripes, or logos. **Socks are required.**

**Shoes (Choose Velcro or slip on for children that have not yet learned to tie.)**

Most of the shoes should be **black, navy, brown, gray, or true white** and free of embellishments.

**Shorts, Skirts, Skorts**

Jeans or solid **blue, black, gray, khaki, leopard, or camouflage** in color (**think "earth tones"**), free of logos and reach the top of the knee. Clothing should fit correctly, loose but snug.

**Slacks, Jeans**

Jeans or solid **blue, black, gray, khaki, leopard, or camouflage** in color (**think "earth tones"**), free of logos. Clothing should fit correctly, loose but snug. **Leggings are treated as tights** and bottoms may be covered unless there are distinct square pockets on the bottom area of the leggings.

**Sweaters, Layered-long-sleeve undershirt**

Solid **blue, black, gray, khaki, leopard, or camouflage** in color (**think "earth tones"**), free of logos.

**Shirt/Sweatshirt**

Lakewood Lutheran School t-shirt or sweatshirt with leopard mascot.

**Socks**

Solid **blue, black, gray, khaki, leopard, or camouflage** in color (**think "earth tones"**), free of logos. **Socks are required.**

**Shoes** (Choose Velcro or slip on for children that have not yet learned to tie.)

Most of the shoes should be **black, navy, brown, gray, leopard, camouflage, or true white** and free of embellishments.

**Shoe Laces**

Should match the main shoe color: **black, navy, brown, gray, leopard, camouflage, or true white.**
