

Items beyond this list – may be left at home. Thank you.

ALL STUDENTS:

- 1 **Box of Kleenex**
- 1 Pack of Small **Disposable Drinking Cups**
- 1 Reusable **water bottle** with a sealing lid
LABELED with student name
- 1 **Full-size backpack** (to hold 1-inch binder)
- 1 **Earthquake Kit** (Three days of food and drink your child would eat in case of an emergency, only items that do not have to be cooked or refrigerated. You may also add comfort items such as a family photo. ****We have found, for storage purposes, one gallon Ziploc of water/beverage and one gallon Ziploc of food stores nicely in their lower cubby.**)
- 1 **Paint Shirt** (Long sleeve, thicker material or plastic, old shirt from home or store bought)
- 1 **Change of clothes**, does not have to be uniform clothes, in case of accidents or emergencies (socks, underwear, pants and shirt, put it all in a large Ziploc bag.)

Optional/Recommended items:

- * **Lunch box**, students that attend school all day bring their own lunch daily (12:15pm), all students also eat a morning snack.
- * **Rain boots and warm jackets** of any color are to be worn only outside, please send school uniform shoes and sweaters to keep children warm in class. As the weather cools, unless it is pouring rain, we will still bundle up and go outside for a brief time. Students must be able to change into rain boots themselves or they may wear school uniform color boots for the school day.
